Verse of the Day:

“Now when Daniel knew that the document was signed, he entered his house; and he continued kneeling on his knees three times a day, praying and giving thanks to his God. Then the king gave orders, and Daniel was brought in and cast into the lion’s den. Then the king spoke and said to Daniel, “Daniel servant of the Living God, your God whom you constantly serve will Himself deliver you. Then the king went off to his palace and spent the night fasting, and no entertainment was brought before him.

Then the king rose at dawn, at the break of day, and went in haste to the lion’s den...Then the king spoke and said to Daniel, “Daniel, servant of the Living God, has your God, whom you constantly serve, been able to deliver you from the lions?” Then Daniel spoke to the king, “O king live forever! Then Darius the king wrote to all the people...I make a decree that in all the dominion of my kingdom men are to fear and tremble before the God of Daniel; “For He is the Living God and enduring forever, And His Kingdom is one which will not be destroyed, And His dominion will be forever. He delivers and rescues and performs signs and wonders in heaven and on earth.” (Daniel 6:10, 16, 18, 20-21, 25-27 NASB)
